The following need to be brought to your attention:

- 1. The £659.95 received in 2014 for the Deenabandu Fellowship has been remitted in 2015
- 2. Living Partnership Conference.

The contribution of £250.00 expected from the CNI/CSI Forum has been received in 2015.

3. The Annual provision of £300.00 towards the triennial Unity Lecture has been made.

Although the financial position of the FCI looks healthy (thanks mainly to the legacies received) the FCI in fact incurred an over-expenditure of £1,560.70 in 2013 and £1,388.62 in 2014, creating a total deficit in the Income & Expenditure account of £2,949.32 in just 2 years.

Finally, on a personal note, I'm sorry to have to give up my job as treasurer of the FCI on health grounds. I wish to thank Rev Dr Gordon Shaw for his help & guidance. My thanks also to Rev Jessie Anand and Rev William Allberry.
